

**Milbemycin Oxime (Interceptor®), Sentinel Spectrum®, Sentinel® Drs.

**Milbemycin is an oral medication used as a wormer and heartworm preventive. Doses vary widely depending upon the condition being treated. Do NOT use in doses higher than the recommended heartworm prevention dose, except under veterinary supervision. Studies support the safety of milbemycin products in Collies and other breeds when used at the recommended heartworm prevention dose. For heartworm prevention, follow the testing and dosing schedule recommended by your veterinarian for your geographical area. Side effects are rarely seen but may include depression, lethargy, vomiting, staggering, loss of appetite, diarrhea, seizures, weakness, or excessive salivation. In addition to medications, reducing exposure to mosquitoes will reduce the risk of heartworm infection. The elimination of other parasites must also include sanitation and prevention measures to ensure the pet does not become reinfected.**
